First Song Title: "Lookin' Back", guess I was a bit too serious in high school

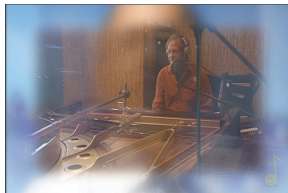
